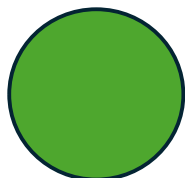
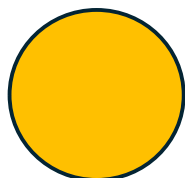


## Capsule Sponge Clinic - What Happens Next?

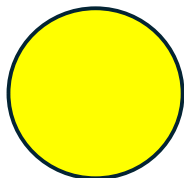
The sponge will be sent off for testing, after which you will be contacted to tell you the next steps. These are:



- The test was negative. This means no abnormal cells were present, so you will continue with your current treatment for your symptoms.



- The test showed some abnormal cells. This means you will be referred for a camera test at the hospital. This does not mean you have cancer, but it is important for us to understand the cause of these abnormal cells and identify what treatment, if any, you need. You will receive a letter from the hospital team



- The test was uncertain. This means there were not enough cells collected on the sponge to test, or the results were unclear, so you will be contacted to arrange another test.
